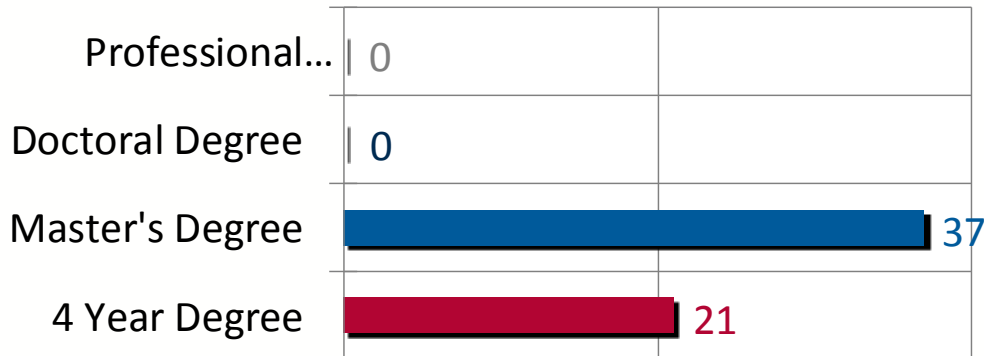

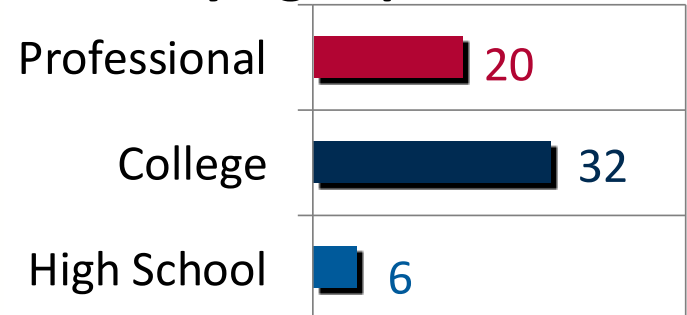

## Highest Level of Education

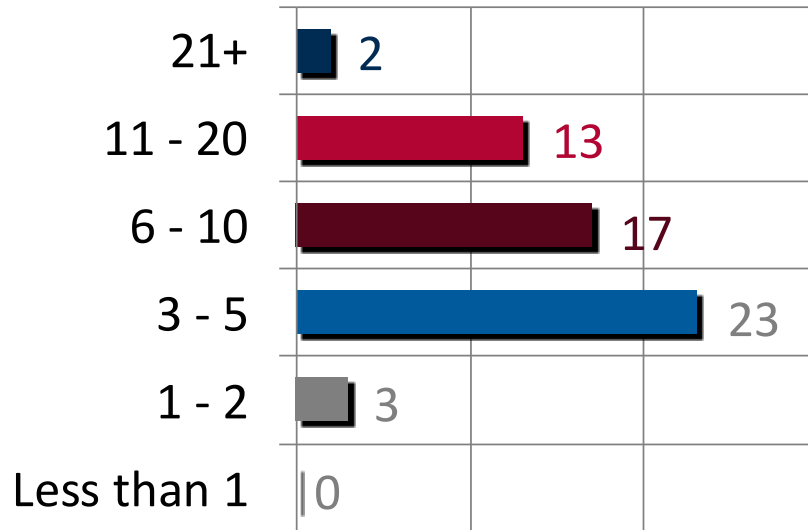


## Highest Level of Playing Experience

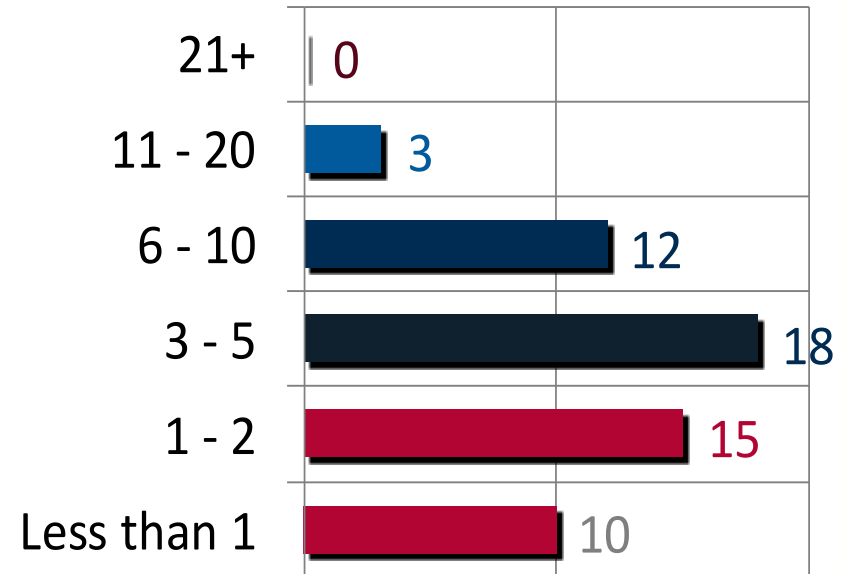

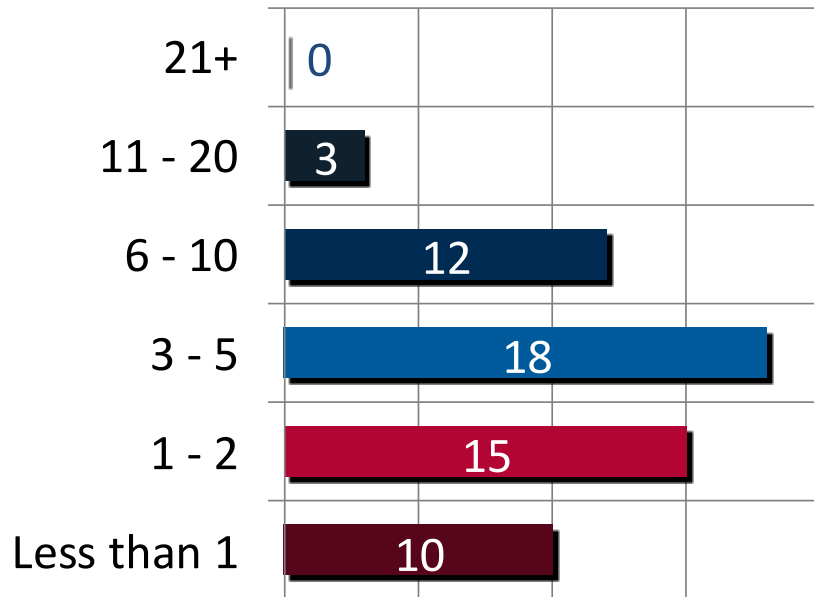

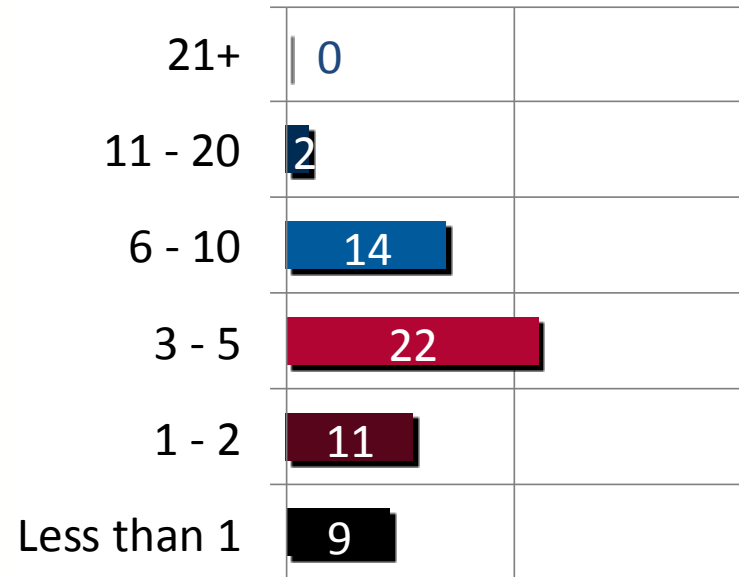

## Years at Current School

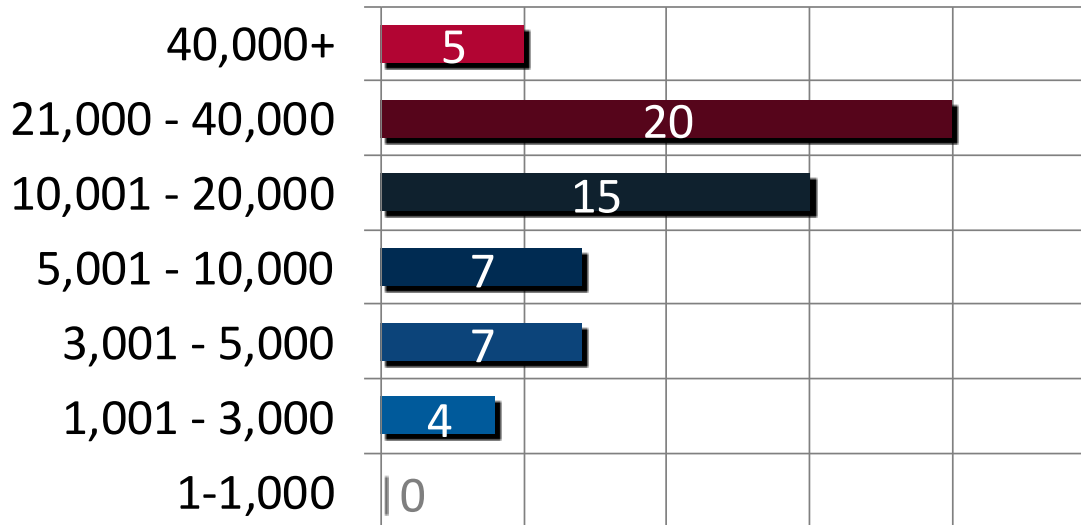

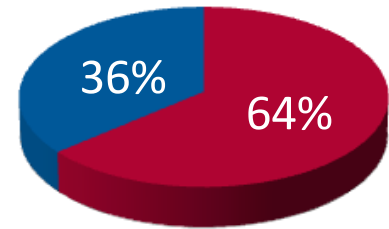

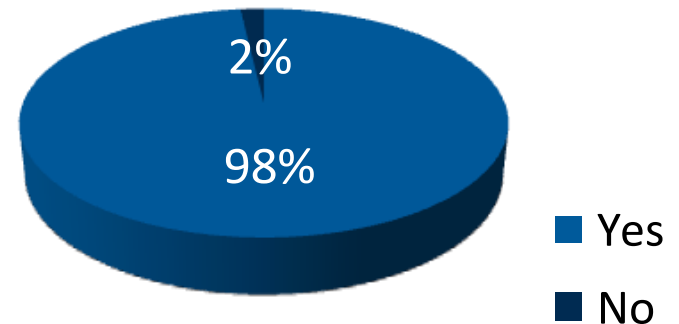

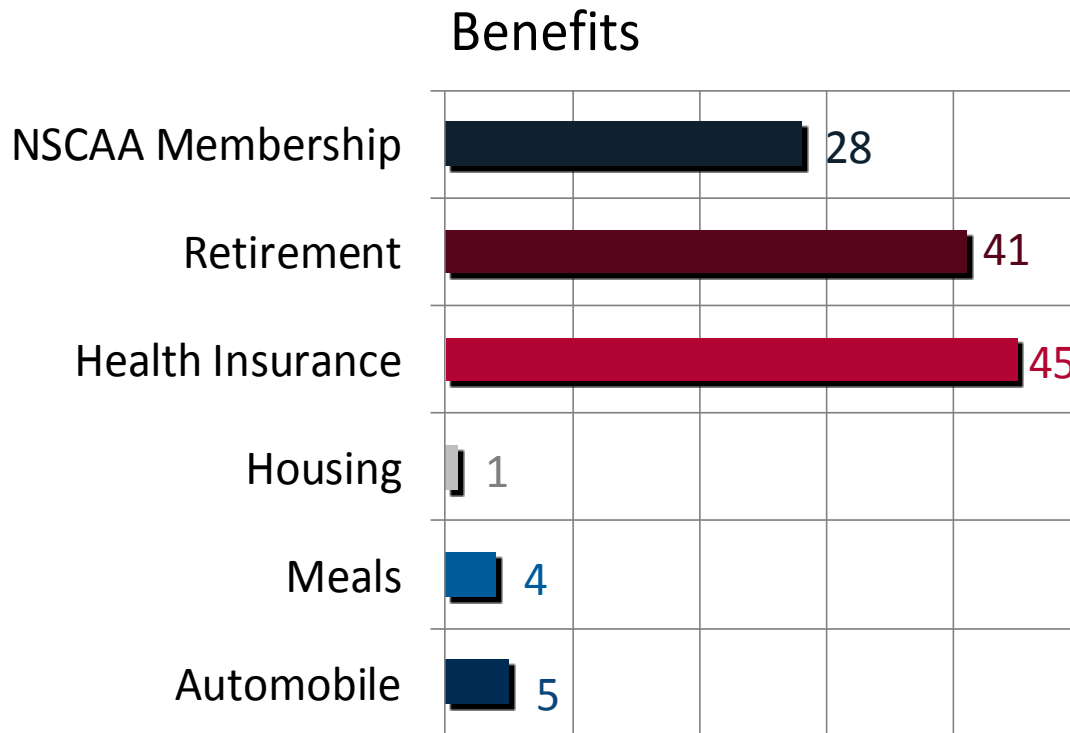
# Income

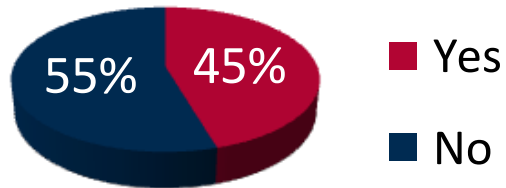

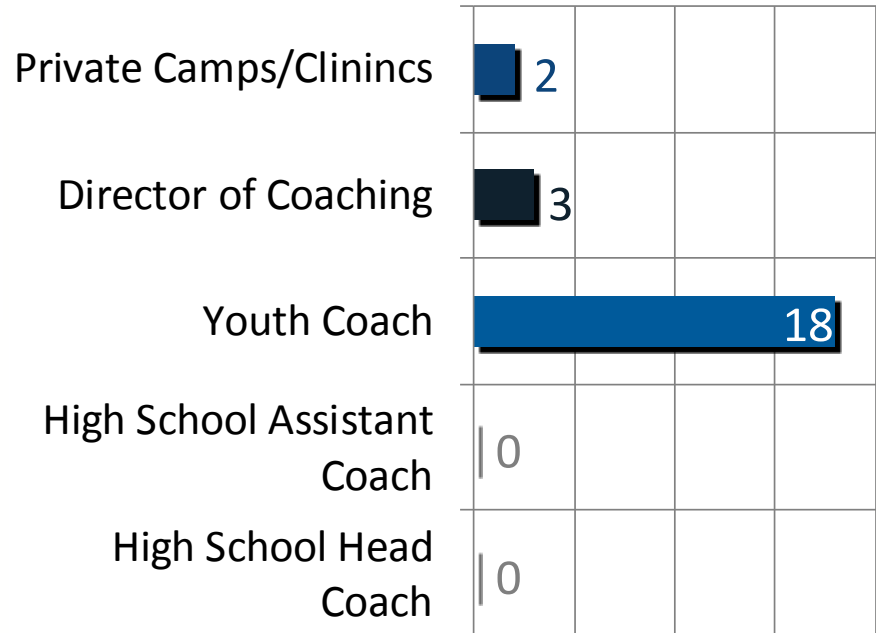

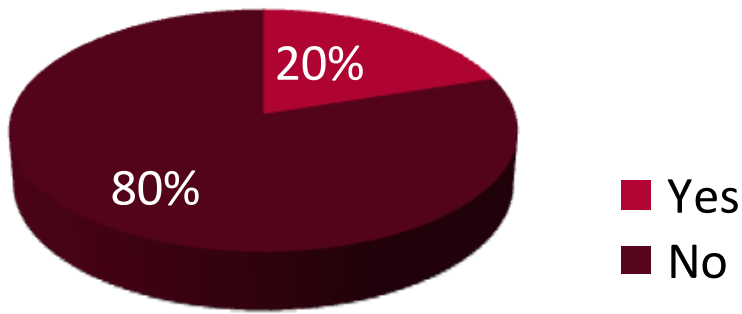
